What is the pass rate for IB biology? Undoubtedly, IB Biology is a demanding course. However, with dedication and perseverance, it is attainable. Statistics from the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO) indicate that in May 2023, the average score for IB Biology exams was 4.28 out of 7, with a pass rate of 90.8%.

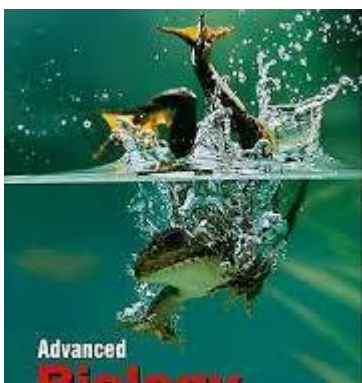


Figure Advanced Biology for You by Gareth Williams (Paperback, 2000)
